

### **Dog Park Rules:**

You are entering an off leash dog park at your own risk.

Open Hours: 8:00 AM to Sunset

All Posted Rules must be observed.

This dog park is for residents only and dogs who reside in the community full time. Guests (both human and dog) are not allowed. Badges are required to use the facility.

1. Dogs are the only animal permitted in the dog park. Do not bring or allow any other animal to enter the park.
2. Upon entering/exiting park, gates must be kept closed and all dogs on their leash.
3. Dogs are to be off leash while in the park but must remain under handler's control.
4. Do not leave dog unattended in the dog park.
5. Two (2) dog maximum per household allowed at the park. No puppies under four (4) months are allowed in the dog park.
6. Owners are responsible for any/all damages or injuries caused by themselves or their tenants. The Association, its Directors, employees, vendors, or volunteers are not responsible for the actions of the people or dogs using the facilities.
7. Dog must have current rabies, vaccinations and licenses as required by local law and always wear a visible dog license and tags with owner identification information on them.
8. Dogs that are sick, contagious or in heat are prohibited.
9. Clean up and disposal of waste is mandatory.
10. Dogs that demonstrate aggressive behavior and/or bark excessively must be removed immediately.
11. All dogs must be under the control of their owner who is able to control the animal physically always. Owners who are not responsible and physically able to control the dog in the dog park may bring another person to accompany them to ensure that they are able to always maintain control over the dog.
12. Park users must remain in dog park area and may not enter Utility Easement, gated areas, or V-Ditch drainage area.
13. Do not bring personal human or animal food to the park.
14. No glass is allowed in park at any time.
15. Smoking and alcohol use is prohibited.

This is a community park, operated and maintained by the HOA. Please be courteous and use common sense while enjoying this amenity. Be a good neighbor to those who do not use the park/neighborhood homes and minimize any disturbance.
